QUESTION

Which implementation of OpenPGP does EFT use?

ANSWER

Enhanced File Transfer (EFT) adheres to the OpenPGP standard and is RFC 4880 compliant. Note that OpenPGP is a standard and has no version. Refer to <u>RFC 4880</u> for details.

EFT supports the following ciphers for OpenPGP:

- IDEA
- 3-DES
- CAST 5
- Twofish
- AES128
- AES192
- AES256

EFT supports the following hashing algorithms for OpenPGP:

- MD 5
- SHA -1
- RIPEMD-160
- SHA-256
- SHA-384
- SHA-512
