CuteHTML has been discontinued.

PROBLEM

Edit with CuteHTML shows up when I right click on the **Windows Start button** or the **Recycle Bin**.

CAUSE

By default, CuteHTML is setup to use right-click shell integration for folders. There is a problem in the way that functionality is implemented in the program.

RESOLUTION

To fix the problem, follow these steps:

1. Start CuteHTML 2.

2. On the **Tools** menu click **Settings**.

Right-click menu item for Edit with CuteHTML shows up improperly (DEPRECATED)

3. On the **Editor** tab, clear the **Right-click shell integration for folders** check box and then click **OK**.
