

Disabling the COMB Command

THE INFORMATION IN THIS ARTICLE APPLIES TO:

- EFT Server version 5.1.1 and later

DISCUSSION

In EFT Server 5.1.1 and later, you can create/edit a registry location to disable the COMB command to avoid problems with multipart uploads causing multiple file upload events. Restricting transfers to one-part uploads will result in slower transfers, but greatly reduces headaches when you want to process uploaded files, because a file upload success is the entire file. This option is disabled by default (legacy behavior), but setting this DWORD registry value to a non-zero integer causes COMB to be disallowed and not shown in the response to FEAT.

On 32-bit systems:

```
[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\GlobalSCAPE Inc.\EFT Server 3.0\]
```

On 64-bit systems:

```
[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Wow6432Node\GlobalSCAPE Inc.\EFT Server 3.0\]
```

```
"DisableCOMBCommand"=dword:00000001
```
