Which SFTP Commands are Supported by EFT Server?

ANSWER

Below is the list of SFTP commands that EFT Server supports. (Confirmed by GlobalSCAPE Engineers on 3-10-2010.)

EFT version 8.0 -8.1 use the OpenSSH library version 8.1.0.0, including OpenSSH DLLs for FIPS. EFT version 8.2.1 uses OpenSSH library version 9.5. EFT version 8.3.0 and later uses OpenSSH version 9.8. The supported list of commands remains the same.

SSH_FXP_INIT	Protocol Initialization
SSH_FXP_REALPATH	Canonicalizing the Server-Side Path Name
SSH_FXP_OPENDIR	Opening a Directory
SSH_FXP_READDIR	Reading Directories
SSH_FXP_STAT	Retrieving Attributes
SSH_FXP_LSTAT	Retrieving Attributes
SSH_FXP_FSTAT	Retrieving Attributes
SSH_FXP_CLOSE	Closing Handles
SSH_FXP_OPEN	Opening a File
SSH_FXP_READ	Reading Files
SSH_FXP_WRITE	Writing Files
SSH_FXP_SETSTAT	Setting File Attributes
SSH_FXP_FSETSTAT	Setting File Attributes
