

## AD users are able to delete virtual folders

### THE INFORMATION IN THIS ARTICLE APPLIES TO:

- EFT Server, all versions

### SYMPTOM

AD users are able to delete virtual folders.

### RESOLUTION

By default users can delete and rename virtual folders. The registry entry below allows you to disable this capability.

For v6.4 and later:

**64 bit:** HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\Software\Wow6432Node\GlobalSCAPE Inc.\EFT Server 4.0\

**32-bit:** HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\Software\GlobalSCAPE Inc.\EFT Server 4.0\

Create the DWORD `AllowDeleteVFSFolders` and specify one of the following values:

The following values can be used to control which date is used in the comparison:

- 0 - disable
- 1 - enable

For v6.1-6.3.x:

**64 bit:** HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Wow6432Node\GlobalSCAPE\EFT Server 3.0\Settings\

**32-bit:** HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\GlobalSCAPE\EFT Server 3.0\Settings\
