- EFT, when using Java applet, all versions (Not available in v7.3.3.21 and later)
- Mail Express, when using Java applet, all versions

### **SYMPTOM**

Cannot send a file in the browser using the Java applet; the Applet is unable to connect to the server

### **RESOLUTION**

Download and install the "Java Cryptography Extension (JCE) Unlimited Strength Jurisdiction Policy Files 8 Download"

<http://www.oracle.com/technetwork/java/javase/downloads/jce8-download-2133166.html>

from Oracle to allow a Java instance to support "strong" ciphers.

### **MORE INFORMATION**

When Java attempts SSL connections, it cannot, by default, use strong ciphers (256bit and higher) \*unless\* the computer running Java deploys a specific Policy file to enable strong ciphers.
