

This article demonstrates how to use the EFT API with Curl.

Get File/folder list

`curl.exe --user rguzman:123 -X GET http://192.168.111.250:81/`



Download file

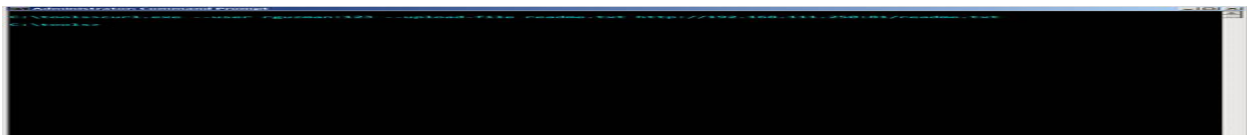
