

Specify a maximum allowable age for OCSP stapling responses

- EFT v7.3.6 and later

DISCUSSION

This setting is used to specify a maximum allowable age for OCSP stapling responses. A value of 0 means to cache responses until the "next update." But if you need to refresh OCSP tokens more frequently, this lets you specify the frequency. Normally, "next update" is sufficient.

In v8.0 and later:

Add the name:value pair to the AdvancedProperties.JSON file as described in the "Advanced Properties" topic in [the online help](#) for your version of EFT.
