Upgrading from v7 to v8: WTC - Workspaces Customizations

THE INFORMATION IN THIS ARTICLE APPLIES TO:

- EFT, v7.4.x and later
- Refer to the EFT v8 help installed with EFT for more information about upgrading and customizations in v8.

QUESTION

When upgrading from EFT v7.4.x to v8.x, does it keep my customizations?

ANSWER

- Customization refers to changes to functionality or interfaces.
- Branding refers to changing logos and color scheme to match company branding.

Going from v7.4.x to v8 is a MAJOR upgrade and EFT does NOT retain any WTC customizations or branding between major upgrades. Going from 8.x to 8.y we should retain customizations or branding , provided they are done in an approved manner.

Customizations done by clients are not officially supported by Globalscape, as we have no say in how they were done or whether those observed best practices.

For any work performed (including but not limited to branding and customizations) by our Professional Services team on behalf of clients, please refer to the SOW executed for such work/services.
