

## Including or excluding VFS folders in quota

### **THE INFORMATION IN THIS ARTICLE APPLIES TO:**

- EFT v8 and later
- In EFT v8.1 and later, you can enable and set upload quota in the VFS. (search the help in EFT for "upload quota.")

### **DISCUSSION**

This advanced property determines whether Virtual Folders are included in the disk quota calculation.

Add the name:value pair below to the AdvancedProperties.JSON file in the \ProgramData\ folder for EFT (for example, **C:\ProgramData\Globalscape\EFT Server**):

```
{  
"ExcludeVFolderInQuotaCalc":1  
}
```

If this value is set to 1, virtual folders are not evaluated when calculating a user's quota restriction.

If set to the default of 0, virtual folders are used in the calculation.
