### **DISCUSSION**

This advanced property specifies whether to treat double slash as a single one in path arguments of FTP commands.

Add the name:value pair below to the AdvancedProperties.JSON file in the \ProgramData\ folder for EFT (for example, **C:\ProgramData\Globalscape\EFT Server**):

"FixDoubleSlashInPathsForFTP":1
}
```

Set to 1 to enable. Default is 0.
